## Introduction

Imagine a community that offers free studio space, collaborations with various artists, the chance to create exhibitions, workshops, and lectures, where personal development and community building are key, where you can develop your work, expand your network, grow interaction with multiple audiences, where you receive artistic guidance, a monthly fee and HAMBURGERS!

## Summary

With the Hamburger Community of Art (HCA), Roodkapje provides a yearlong programme for emerging artists / artist collectives (named *residents*) that entails the organization of events, training and workshops open to various types of audiences.

The Hamburger Community of Art intends to equip its residents as well as its audience with skills to be resourceful and self-sufficient in assembling diverse voices. The HCA is based on the principles of experimentation, collaboration and developing new artistic practices. The HCA will develop, produce and host cultural events, social activities and projects open to all.

The essential question we need to ask ourselves is: What can artists learn from each other? How can young artists stimulate their development collectively? What can society learn from artists and vice versa?

## What do we offer? (1 year)

### Individual level:

exhibitions, personal development, artistic elaboration (growth), expansion of network(s), new concepts and mediums to explore and work with, working with a variety of artists

### Collective level:

(free) studio space, collaboration, co-production, presentations, workshops, lectures, networks, audience

### Practical:

monthly fee, shared studio space, weekly group meetings

### Development:

courses and classes from (inter)national and local artists

## Who do we work with?

Roodkapje crew: a dedicated team that is willing to help, question and guide you

Mentors: Nora Turato, Jeroen Koolhaas, and Aimee Zito Lema

## What do we expect from you?

We expect you to have:

- the experience of having an artistic practice for at least two years
- affinity with Roodkapje

- a vision of developing a sense of audience involvement in your working process or the willingness to develop this vision

We expect you to be:

- dedicated and willing to learn from your peers, mentors, guiding staff and audience
- able and willing to expand your artistic practice
- a Rotterdam resident or willing to travel to Rotterdam
- available and committed for at least two days a week to work in our shared studio
- there during the first four months due to an intensive program with selected mentors
