## **Hamburger Community of Art 2022**

Roodkapje's Hamburger Community of Art is a collaborative and multidisciplinary program for young, emerging artists looking to take new steps in their careers and to further develop exciting ways to engage with audiences through visual art, performances, exhibitions, workshops and other interdisciplinary events. The Hamburger Community of Art offers its residents a shared studio environment within Roodkapje, a monthly fee, and trajectory of mentorships and guidance, and entails the organisation of exhibitions, workshops, publications and events with other artists in the program and the programmers-in-residence of the Hamburger Community of Live.

The Hamburger Community is the place where you can develop your practice, expand your network, receive (artistic) guidance and the opportunity to experiment with presenting and sharing your work, ideas, practice, in new ways for a diverse audience.

The Hamburger Community of art is an environment that is collaborative, multidisciplinary, dynamic and aimed at a direct connection between artist and audience. The program offers a trajectory focused on collaboration, collective learning, experiment and public mediation, where you and your fellow residents can share skills, ideas and learn from experienced artists and other cultural professionals. The programme aims to enable young and emerging artists to work directly with the public and find new ways and forms in which their art can do so.

## **What do we Offer (March-December 2022)**

- A Solo exhibition at Roodkapje
- Opportunity to present your work in different public settings within Roodkapje's multidisciplinary location
- Personal guidance and development for your work and practice
- Working directly with other artists, residents in the Hamburger Community of Live and cultural professionals
- Expanding and developing your artistic practice in a unique, multidisciplinary and dynamic environment
- A monthly stipend of € 416,67 ex. VAT
- 24/7 access to Roodkapje and our facilities
- A shared studio space, group sessions with feedback, three mentorship trajectories working with renowned artists, and a program of various visiting experts
- A DIY material budget for your solo exhibition

## **What do we expect from you?**

- You are an artist with at least one year of professional and/or active experience, you do not have to have a degree in arts to apply

- You have great affinity with Roodkapje, its interdisciplinary program and DIY-mentality
- You have a vision or great desire to (further) develop your practice as an artist in a direct relationship with a diverse audience
- You are dedicated and willing to learn from your peers, mentors, guiding staff and audience
- You have a pluriform artistic practice or the desire to develop one
- You have a demonstrable urge to engage with audiences in a direct way and for a place to present your work and research
- You are committed and able to make Roodkapje your base during the residency
- You are excited about the opportunity to work collaboratively and in an open way with your peers and Roodkapje's staff
- You are a Rotterdam resident or willing and able to move to Rotterdam
- You are capable and available to start your residency by 1st of March 2022
- That you can commit to expressing yourself openly while also allowing space for others to do so

### **How to Apply**

Are you excited and ready to be part of the Hamburger Community of Art? We would like to read all about you and your work. To make sure we can make the most of your residency, please include the following documents in your application:

- Artist CV
- Portfolio with recent works
- A general letter of motivation including why you want to attend the HCA, how you intend to use the facilities we offer, and how you intend to share your practice and research with the audience (max. 300 words)
- A specific proposal for a project or research trajectory to undertake during the residency, in which you demonstrate your desire to exhibit and your relationship to your audience, including a potential collaboration with the HCL and a workshop (max. 500 words)
